Town of Bow Island Spring Cleaning



The Town of Bow Island will again assist you in the spring clean up happening **on Tuesday, May 26th**. If you wish to take advantage of this service, refuse must be placed in a brown paper bags and all branches **MUST** be cut smaller and securely bundles (All piles of branches should be shorter than 48" in and no bigger than 6" in diameter.) and place in your back lane **BEFORE MAY 26th**. You must use **BROWN PAPER BAGS** for all your grass and leaves. (Bow Island Hardware will have some available for purchase) in that way Public Works staff can recycle the leaves, grass and bags to the compost site. **NO GARBAGE IS ALLOWED.**

We will **NOT** accept appliances, electronics, dirt, cement and loose tree branches.

At this time, we also request that all property owners do all necessary pruning of backyard trees to allow the garbage truck clear access through the back lane!
