

Aggregate Recycling: Concrete and Asphalt S-00-08

Date: June 13, 2022

Policy Statement: The Town of Bow Island recycles concrete and asphalt from household and private renovations, construction, and demolition projects. This service provides an economical source of aggregates that are used to build and maintain the Town's roads. However, the Town recognizes that there are significant costs involved with handling, storing, crushing aggregate, and operation of the collection area.

This policy defines recyclable materials and identifies opportunities for the Town to offset costs for recycling.

Acceptable Materials:

✓ Asphalt Millings, asphalt rubble, brick and paving stones, concrete (mesh free), concrete rubble, concrete (with embedded rebar), gravel, Concrete Stucco (mesh free).

Maximum size: 90 cm by 90 cm, 3 feet by 3 feet or as approved by PW Manager.

Unacceptable Materials:

Asphalt shingles, rubberized asphalt, dirt, clay, sand, ceramic or porcelain tile, concrete truck washouts, concrete or stucco with wire mesh, drywall, plaster stucco. marble, natural rock.

Policy:

- 1. Acceptable materials must be dropped off at the collection area during designated operating hours (unless otherwise approved by the Public Works Manager).
- 2. Town Residents may drop off acceptable materials that are obtained from residential household sources at no charge.
- 3. Commercial Contractors may drop off acceptable materials that are sourced from within and without the Town limits at the following rates:

Gross Vehicle Weight	Price Per Load
Over 23,600 kg (semi with trailer)	\$100.00
9,000 kg to 23,600 kg (single or tandem axle truck)	\$50.00
Less than 9,000 kg (small dump trailers, small dumping truck)	\$25.00

4. All loads must be prepaid at the Town Office unless otherwise approved by the Public Works Manager.
